On behalf of Oklahoma State University, I would like to invite your institution to participate in our 8<sup>th</sup> Annual International Symposium on Student Affairs from June 3<sup>rd</sup> to June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2016. This one-week symposium features scholarly lectures on student development theories, group tours of student affairs facilities, academic tours and scholarly peer discussions on best practices and critical issues of student affairs professions in China. The featured lectures will emphasize career services and career development programs, residential life (living-learning communities) and leadership development, student conduct issue and new student orientation programs. The topic of university facilities and community building was received positively last year and will be continued this year as well. Based on the feedback from last year, we will also add two new topics next year, which are the challenges and applications of social media in student affairs and overview of campus wide entrepreneurship education and initiatives.

The invaluable feedback that we collected from the past years symposium participants has allowed us to enhance the upcoming symposium and provide even greater opportunity for cultural exchange as well as a more in depth examination of student affairs.
