2020 NATIONAL GEOGRAPHY CHALLENGE OF THE JUNIOR PHILIPPINE  
GEOGRAPHICAL SOCIETY-UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES DILIMAN

The Junior Philippine Geographical Society-University of the Philippines (JPGS-UP) Diliman will conduct the 2020 National Geography Challenge with the theme, *Pag-unlad: Para Kanino at Para Saan?* on March 7, 2020 at the UP Diliman, Quezon City.

The event aims to

1. promote the distinct discipline of geography and its importance and relevance to the society;
2. provide a venue for alternative learning of the discipline of geography outside the four walls of the classroom;
3. develop geographic literacy and social awareness towards the participants;
4. foster camaraderie and develop leadership skills and potential among the youth; and
5. encourage active participation of students and teachers.

The 2020 National Geography Challenge is composed of the following sub-events:

1. Poster Making Contest,
2. Impromptu Speech Contest,
3. Photo Essay Contest,
4. Short Film Contest,
5. Geography Quiz, and
6. Geography Quiz Bowl.

The event is open to students from Grades 9 to 12 in public and private schools nationwide.
