# Intensive English for the Global Citizen Program

3 or 4 weeks, 27 hours/week

Offered by the UBC Continuing Studies English Language Institute, the English for the Global Citizen (EGC) program is designed for students seeking to improve their language skills while learning about sustainability, global citizenship and civil society.

### EGC offers students the opportunity to:

- improve speaking and listening skills, increase vocabulary, enhance fluency and pronunciation
- develop academic writing skills and grammar
- build critical reading abilities
- learn in a supportive environment, collaborating with other students under the direction of experienced language instructors
- actively participate in debates and discussion forums, be exposed to guest lecturers and conduct research for oral presentations and written reports.
